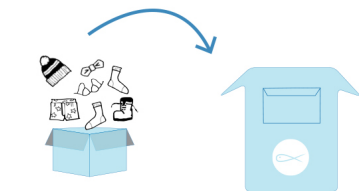
WHO ARE WE?

Take 2 masks for an entire day or 1 for half day

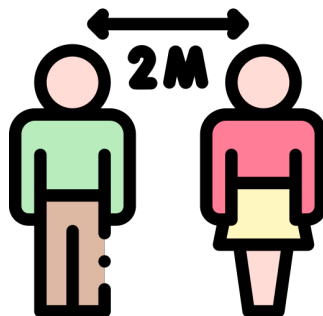


Hydroalcoholic gel on each sorting table
